## TO ZOOM – PHONE

1. Dial any **one** of these four numbers

2. A voice will say “Welcome to zoom, please enter your Meeting ID followed by #. The Meeting ID’s are on the previous page (you don’t leave any spaces)
3. A voice will then say “If you are a participant please press # to continue” so do just that!
4. You should then be through to the service. The host tries to ask those who have phoned in who they are relatively quickly.
5. During the service you will be ‘muted’ so no one can hear what you say or any background noise. After the service you can join the conversation which is normally done by inviting one person at a time to ‘unmute’ and say something. To unmute you need to press ‘\*6’ i.e. the star or asterisk key followed by the number 6.
